

**North Florida Area 14 Assembly Minutes**  
**2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter, April 10-11, 2010**  
**Theme “Enthusiasm and Gratitude in Action”**

**Area Chair:** Glenn W. called meeting to order at 9:05 AM. Serenity Prayer was said. The AA Anonymity Statement was read and the Short Form of the Twelve Concepts was read.

**Registrar:** Roll call was taken by Andy D. As each district was called for attendance of D.C.M., Alternate D.C.M., and number of G.S.R.’s and alternate G.S.R.’s present. All officers and service coordinators were present. 210 total voting members for assembly.

**Officer Reports:**

**Secretary:** Kelly J. Motions from Jan. Assembly were emailed to webmaster 7 days after assembly and are under password protected area of our website. Cost of printing 675 copies of the minutes \$415.99. Mailed minutes were not sent out 30 days prior to the assembly. No changes to the minutes. All were in favor.

**Treasurer:** Laura M. Let’s start on the top of the Balance Sheet – combined cash on hand is \$65,052.34. If  
you go to the next page, Income & Expense report shows our budgeted amount for contributions for 2010 was \$48,000. Note that we had total contributions of \$9,280.95. This is \$ 2,719.05 below estimated contributions. If you look at page 3, of the Income & Expense report you’ll see Expenses budgeted for 2010 are \$65,272.00. Our actual 2010 Expenses are \$11,643.42. We are below budgeted expenses at this time. Prudent Reserve Overage Report was absorbed in the budget changes we made last quarter.

**Delegate Panel 59:** Delegate: Chet P. recognized the Past Area 14 Delegates seated in the audience: Dan E., Panel 45; Dick G., Panel 47 and Past SE Regional Trustee; Kathy P., Panel 49; Corliss G., Panel 53; Michael S., Panel 55; Fred H., Panel 57. Chet also recognized Steve P., Panel 55, of Area 15.

Cecilia and I attended the Delegates’ Get Together in February. The vote on the SERASSA agenda and changes to the conduct of Regional business will be considered at the Regional Luncheon at this year’s Conference because of the prohibition against doing business at the Delegate’s Get Together.

The following are the highlights of the Trustee’s report:

Anonymity breaks on social networks are a growing concern: GSO is receiving 1,000 e-mails a week complaining about anonymity breaks. Also there is a warning about cell phone pictures at the International Convention.

On line contributions can be made on the aa.org website: now accepting credit cards and soon electronic checks. Total book sales are up. Non-AA sales are 30.6% which is an increase from about 20 % from last year; however, Hazelden ordered a 3 year supply of Big Books prior to price increase so impact uncertain.

There were 1,224,346 Big Books sold in all format.

Finance: Literature sales are up, but contributions are down.

Contributions were 43% of total income: they are still \$ 6,162,700, but \$ 218,600 less than last year. Paid circulation for the Grapevine is down. Grapevine had a loss of \$ 129,000 last year. La Vina had a \$ 54,472 loss; Projected 2010 loss for Grapevine is \$ 245,741; part of the deficit budget is to upgrade and turn around the Grapevine with more electronic selections, which will have more appeal to young people.

International Convention: 32,000 have already registered for International Convention.

While procedural I want to be correct and trust that if one of my panel recommends a procedural change that is "legitimately" correct based on accounting rules, this still may not be the best way for Alcoholics Anonymous to work. I want to make this very clear right away, I certainly did not want to take any power away from the Groups by not asking for a motion to accept. I absolutely believe all of our actions and reports should be transparent to those we serve. We will be discussing this in July so I can find a better way that satisfies both the Accountants and the groups for which we serve. Also, I want to again encourage you to come participate in the "Ask the Officers" meeting on Saturday afternoons.


