MINUTES OF MEETING

the biennial meeting of the North Florida Assembly of Alcoholics Anonymous was held in the meeting room of the Central Brevard Group in Cocoa on Sunday, November 17, 1968, at 2:00 P.M. Thirty-two groups participated in the elections.

Chairman Bert L. opened the meeting with a moment of silence followed by the Serenity Prayer and calling the meeting to order, he briefly explained the duties and the tenure of two years which each General Service Representative should accept as an important responsibility. The Chairman quoted and referred to the guide lines in the Third Legacy Manual and recommended that they be followed. His recommendations were approved and accepted.

Chairman Bert L. introduced our present Delegate, Harry G., from Jacksonville, and thanked him for his excellent work during the past two years.

Delegate Harry G. outlined his experience at the past two General Service Conference Meetings in New York and described them as being of great value to the Fellowship and for himself it was a very rewarding episode. Harry also emphasized the requisits for the office of Delegate. He expressed his appreciation to everyone for their help during his term but stating he would be unable to serve in the capacity of Chairman, never-the-less he would be on call for less time demanding tasks. Everyone present gave Harry their applause for a job well done.

The Chairman then outlined the seven areas in the North Florida Conference Area and described their boundaries. He explained the Third Legacy Manual's suggestions for the selection of a delegate and the type of member who would qualify. He also asked for the approval and received it to follow the new method of election as described on Page 34 of the Final Report of the Eighteenth General Service Conference of AA, 1968. A motion to accept the new method was seconded and passed unanimously.

The Chairman called for the election of a new Delegate to serve two years beginning January 1, 1969. On the first ballot Earl M. of the Central Brevard Group was elected by securing more than a two-thirds majority.



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Earl M. was called on for a few words and very graciously accepted the job and thanked everyone for the trust they had placed in him. He then gave a Treasurer's report and said that financial matters were in a satisfactory condition with a balance on hand of \$365.87, with a few small bills outstanding. He then left the books open for review.

The next order of business was the election of a new Chairman. A recess was called during which time the various District G.S.R.s caucused and elected their respective Committee Member who would be eligible for the Chairmanship. When the recessed meeting was called to order, balloting started and on the fourth ballot Dave C, of St. Augustine, was elected Chairman to serve two years beginning January 1, 1969. The new committee then selected Marge B. of the Satellite Beach Group, Satellite Beach, as their Secretary and Jess P. as Treasurer, both to serve two years beginning January 1, 1969.
